Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): Steven Beaty took charge of the pre-sale show at the "March Milkiers", placing Brian Haygarth's 1st placed heifer as his champion. She was a smart 15day calved 28l heifer which later realised £1980, selling to the judge. The top call of the day came from John Park at £2100 for his very correct 6 gal heifer, closely followed by Stephen Birkett's first heifer at £2000. On the whole not the best show forward, better sorts £1500-£1750 with a number of plainer cattle £1050-£1450, reflected in the overall average of £1375. Cows to £1620 from PW&DM Swindlehurst with their 1st prize 3rd calver.

AUCTIONEER'S REPORT (Greg MacDougall):-Another good show forward with once again the strongest outfits meeting a strong demand, with ewes with younger lambs, although a good trade, finding a more limited demand. Continental ewes with twins topped at £240 from SJ&AL Dennis, followed at £235 from Chris Hewitt. S Sleightholme of York sold older ewes with twin lambs to £200, with James Burr selling mules to £200 also. WM&E Dugdale, showing for the first time this season, sold B/M ctls to £190 with mules to £180. Ewes with singles in general £60-£70 a life, topping at £140 from S Sleightholme.

Prime Hogs: Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall):- A fantastic show of 4616 prime hogs forward with another animated trade. Heavy hogs in particular good to sell with an average for this weight category alone 241.4p. Very much a two tier sale with some good runs of fed hogs as well as plenty of tail end and hill bred sheep. An overall market average of 219.6p was fair on the night. Commercial export weights 230-250p with plainer types 200-220p. Best bred hogs good to sell once again, often between 260-300p. Hitting the high spots once again was East Mains at 302.3p, 301.2p with others to 296.5p and 296.1p. Heavy hogs regularly £125-£145 topping at £147.50, once again from East Mains, who sold other heavy hogs to £146 x 2, £145.50, £143.50, £141.50 and £140 x 2. Another great run of mostly Suffolkx hogs from Robert and Alan Lamont of Berwickshire averaged £106.97, topping twice at £125 for 50kg Suffolks. The Mellor family from Glossop showed some great Texel x Mules to average £116 topping at £128.50. Handy weight Mules 210-220p with those weighing 44-48kg £95-£98, and 50kg+ £100-£101. Horned hogs to £102.50 from RH Thexton or 219.1p from E&N Wright & Sons. Lightweights 200-220p for best fleshy sorts, topping at £77.50 or 221.4p from JH Thornhill. Plainer types 170-180p. Texels 200-230p. Plenty of buyers still around the ring for store hogs.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): Numbers harder to find with smaller shows being reported around the country. All classes once again good to sell. Strong ctl and Suff ewes £100-£120 with smaller but good selling types £80+, leaner ewes £60-£70. Best bred and pure types, depending on weight, £95-£150, topping at £158.50 for Charollais ewes from first time vendor RJ Tindall & Son, Wetherby. Mule ewes in general £75-£95 with heavier types £100+, topping at £106.50 from RA Booth & Sons, Rathmell. Lean types £50-£60. Horned ewes topped at £80.50 for Roughs from DJ&J Stainton, with a pen from MJ Alpe to £79.50. Best SBF and Swale ewes £60-£70 with a pen of Swales from NJ&S Taylor of Derbyshire to £75. Small types either side of £50 with lean ewes in the £30's. Strong horned rams £75-£84 with lean types £50-£60. Strong Ctl rams £110-£150 topping at £151.50
