AUCTIONEER'S REPORT (Stephen Dennis): Our Thanks to Colin Dent of Greenriggs who carried out the Judging duties over some challenging Blue Faced Leicester classes awarding the champion rosette to the 1 st prize Ram Lamb from G Rawsthorne, Scargill Farm (Lunesdale). The Lamb was sired by Hundith F3 out of a B1 Highberries Ewes later purchased by Richard & Carol Benson for £2200. An overall average of £499.93 was realised for Ram Lambs (down £132 on the year) whilst Shearlings were well sought after to average £729 (up £46 on the year). Top price of the day went to Messrs Huddleston of Snab Green selling their H2 Riddings Shearling out of a B10 Hundith Ewe for £7000 to Robert Hayton of Kirkby Stephen. The Annual consignment from W A & A Booth (Smearset) were again well followed topping at £5000 for a Shearling sired by Smearset G11 out of a Highberries G45 Dam, purchased by the Bainbridge family of Dousgill, Barnard Castle. Aged Blue Faces Leicester Rams averaged £546 (up £136 on the year).

AUCTIONEER'S REPORT (Greg MacDougall):

Lamb trade in keeping with that of the national average, although a much better trade than some local early week sales. An overall average of 158.1p being achieved (SQQ 164.2P) Including a large quantity of lightweight & Store Lambs. Commercial export Lambs 160p-170p with common sorts 150p-160p. Better bred Lambs 180p-220p depending on quality topping at 251.3p or £100.50 from J & A Lawson & Son, High Threaber. Lambs 45kg-48kg £72-£78 with 50kg+ Lambs £85-£88. Handy-weight Mules 150p-156p topping at £71 on several occasions. Horned Lambs with meat around 140p with plainer types around 110p. Lightweight Lambs well fleshed 150p-170p depending on breeds topping at £218.8p from E J Ward & Sons. Those lacking flesh still good to sell with a few store buyers around the ringside often £20-£25 over the kilo weight.
