Smaller sorts £60-£80 with plain ewes £40-£50. Mules in general £64-£70 with some heavy pens £80+, lighter but fleshy types around £58, with the plainer ewes £40+. Best Swale and SBF ewes £40-£48, with heavy types £50-£56. Smaller types either side of £30, with plain ewes £5-£15. REPORT (Greg MacDougall):- Another good entry with 3428 lambs forward, with an overall average of 170.3pkg (SQQ 174.8P) being achieved. A larger entry of the best bred lambs were on offer and good to sell throughout, often 200p-260p depending on quality, topping at 264.6p or £108.50 from regular vendor J & I Whitaker. Lambs weighing 46kg-50kg selling between £76-£84. Lambs 60kg+ £100-£115 topping at £116.50 from J W & L J Mellin, Hull House. Mule lambs selling to an overall average of 160p, with handy weights 160p-170p. Heavier sorts (46kg-48kg) selling between £72-£77. Masham lambs to £81. Best pens of horned lambs 150p-160p topping at £69.50 from A & C M Taylor, Botton Head. Lightweight lambs saw the best Swale lambs 130p-140p topping at 160.3p from CM & SM Faraday, with others 170p-180p and nicer bred lambs 190p-200p.
