## **Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall):**

A much larger entry forward and following last week's bumper trade, all classes sold at reduced rates, although still a good trade overall. The plainer ewes certainly still the best to sell with best types short of requirements. Heavy Continental and Suffolk ewes £90-£100 with good selling types either side of £80. Best bred ewes and pure types selling between £100-£140 depending on weight topping at £141.50 for Texels from East Mains. Heavier Mule ewes £80

-£86 with the next draw down around £75. Lean sorts selling in the £60s. A huge entry of 1135 Horned ewes saw strong Horned breeds £65-£72 with best Swale and SBF ewes £60-£62, medium types in the £50s and lean and plainer end either side of £40. Cast rams in strong demand with strongest types £110-£134 and plainer sorts £80-£90.

### **Auctioneer's Report (Stephen Dennis):**

With lamb trade easing back on the week, an entry of 2237 was expected to prove more challenging than it turned out. An overall average of 205.7p/kg was better than anticipated, bolstered by 12 pens of cracking show lambs topping at £122, mostly between 250p-270p/kg. Heavyweight lambs in keen demand, up to £126.50 for a 56kg Suffolk x from Adam Lawson and a consignment of 40 Suffolk x lambs from Howard Smith of Selby weighing between 44-50kg to average £103.42. Lightweight lambs harder to place often either side of £2/kg.
