Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): A large show of 492 local and travelled stirks forward, with a respectable trade throughout for all classes. Best of the suckler bred sorts into the mid £900s, a Limousin Bullock from Mrs R Capstick hit £940, whilst JR Fothergill, Hawes sold a Lim Heifer at £950. Plenty of nice suckler bred cattle could be bought in the £800s. Younger cattle (5-6months) looking dearer on the month generally £500-£600, whilst the stronger cattle looking the best value for money. Plenty of buyers looking for summering cattle, as spring edges ever so slightly closer. A run of cattle from T Dun & Sons, Brothershiels peaked at £900 for Angus Steers. Black and whites nice to sell, the strongest to £770 from Chris Ellershaw, other well grown 15m sorts in the £600s whilst the yearling grazing types looking the best trade of the day in the mid £400s.

Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): John Minshall of Staffordshire cast his expert eye over the two dairy classes, a straight forward start with the cows, John Fox taking first and second in the class, these 2nd calvers realising £1700 & £1420. A lovely turnout of 13 heifers for the next class- John Waller, Killington was awarded the first place ticket and the champion rosette with his lovely square heifer, calved 12days and yielding 32litres, she was the choice of Tony & Stephen Hunter, Berrier, Cumbria. A run of 10 Heifers from Robin Jennings filled the top shippon and topped at £1980 twice, to average £1720. Last in the ring was Dave Martin, who had a lovely heifer which narrowly escaped the rosettes, she was caught by the eyes of Tom & Jonathon Pollock, Ainstable, Carlisle and sold to the second top price of the day at £2100. A straight trade throughout with 14 active buyers and others going home empty handed, plenty of heifers £1650-£1850, with the better end in the £1900s. Heifers averaged £1756 for all 27 forward, whilst cows levelled at £1490.

Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): A better show of calves this week, with the usual ringside of buyers present. Trade in general similar to previous weeks, with a few younger calves forward which proved slightly harder to place. Angus bulls to a top of £232 & £230 from JA Salthouse & Sons, Elswick, along with PD & BS Lawrence, Grange at £230 also. Others upwards of £200, with a few smaller sorts in the late £180s. Heifers £130-£150, the best to £162 from Alan Duncan, Mewith. A few smalls could be bought just shy of £100. Sticking with the native breeds, a run of Herefords from JM & T Livesey Inskip all generally either side of £200. Continental bulls from Ian Hodgson, Tatham sold to £290 twice, others in the mid £200s, a trio of heifers from David Shuttleworth, Gargrave realised £300, £310 and his last at £320. Good to have a bit more strength in the dairy bulls, the strongest coming from Gibson & Berry, Endmoor at £150, £160, £170. Others regularly £120-£145, younger flashy calves £80-£100, with the mediums £50-£60, averaging £85.

Auctioneer's Report: (Greg MacDougall): A fantastic ewe trade from start to finish with all classes some £10 dearer on the week. The night's sale was topped at £165.50 for Texels from Frankland Farms, Rathmell whose consignment of Mule and Texel x ewes averaged £138. E & M Townley was close behind making £165. Best bred ewes in general £150-£160. Heavy weight ewes £125-£145 with lesser sorts £100-£115. Plain types £70-£90. Heavy Mule ewes £110-£120 with Frankland Farms again topping this section at £122.50. Next cut down either side of £100 with lean ewes £70-£80. Horned ewes peaked at £93.50 for Woodlands from D Shirt with a pen of 45 SBF ewes from G McDougal, Bassendean to £84.50. Best pens in general £75-£83 with mediums £60+ and lean ewes £50+. Strongest of the rams £125-£145 topping at £150 for three Texels from S Sleightholme, York. Well worked sorts £75-£95 with horned types £60 -£74. Goats sold to £82.50 from Malcolm Metcalfe, Thirsk.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): A larger show of prime hoggs forward. Very much a two tier trade. Some marvellous runs of well fed hoggs once again from the Scottish Borders to Lincolnshire but a large proportion of the entry made up of horned and under finished store types all reflecting the overall market average of 223.4p (SQQ 224.2p). Of the total entry, 1585 hoggs were hill bred or Mule sorts with several Texels out of this total being stores and would perhaps be best sold on a Tuesday. Best bred hoggs very short of requirements with plenty of pens 270p-330p topping at 338.4p from C Dean & LJ Brennand. JR Metcalfe, Thirsk was close behind with his best to 336.8p. Commercial export types 230p-250p or in money terms £96-£106 depending on quality. Hoggs weighing 45kg-50kg £103-£118 with a few nicer pens over £120. Heavy hoggs again forward in small numbers for the time of year with trade £125-£135. Handy weight Mules 220p-235p topping at 238.6p from K Marshall, Darley. Lighter sorts (37kg-39kg) around 210p. The heavier pens sold between £106-£110 topping at £115.50. Best horned hoggs to £106.50 for Dalesbreds from AH Price with Roughs to £106 from A & AM Burrow. Trade in general £75-£85 or 215p-235p. Lightweight Continentals sold to £94.50 or 295.3p for Beltex from Matinley Farms, Selkirk.
