Auctioneer's Report: (Greg MacDougall): Despite the sale being held at short notice, a decent entry of 518 in lamb sheep was forward. A consignment of mainly Mule shearlings from T Crick, Beach Farm topped at £140 on four separate occasions with most other pens in the £130s. Mule ewes from the same home sold between £112-£118 topping at £130 for mostly older sorts. D Hallam, Glossop sold a nice run of Mule and Texel hoggs in lamb for mid April. Texels sold to £130 with others selling between £122-£126. Auctioneer's Report: (Greg MacDougall): Just short of 3000 hoggs forward with a very mixed show of quality on offer. Best fleshy fed sorts short of requirements. Trade however was buoyant with a very respectable average of 235p, SQQ 235.1p being achieved. Best bred hoggs 280p-330p depending on quality. Dan Towers sold a nice run to top at 333.8p or £123.50 with CA & A Crowther close behind at 331.1p. Commercial export sorts 240p-260p or in money terms £110-£112. Hoggs weighing 45kg-50kg selling between £115-£125. Heavy weight hoggs forward in few numbers with a cracking run from N Thorndyke topping at £152.50 with plenty of others in the £140s. Handy weight Mules 235p-255p topping at £117.50 from GT & M Lawson. Heavier end in general £110-£115. A cracking pen of 43 **Dalesbreds from Messrs Coates** sold to £114.50. B Dibb sold Gritstones and Lonks to 255p and 248.8p with best Swales 220p-233p or in money terms £90-£107. Still customers for little grazing hoggs with plenty £60-£70.
