B + W Cows to £1080 from DR Robinson or 165p from MJ & K Ayrton CTL Cows to £1287.60 from E & MA Procter or 184p from J & A Lawson & Son

Auctioneer's Report (Stephen Dennis): The biggest entry of cast cows for some time was met with another flying trade from a full compliment of buyers. Beef x cows averaged just shy of 160p/kg topped by Stephen Lawson, Threaber with a BB x cow at 184p/kg whilst first time vendors E & MA Procter, Great Musgrave grossed £1287 (174p/kg) with a Lim x cow. B + W cows in strong demand with well fleshed cows in the 140s. Next draw down 120p-135p/kg. Lean parlour cows 105p-115p/kg. Topping the B + W section was Messrs Ayrton of Bamber Farm selling a 34mo feeding heifer at 165p/kg. Next sale Tuesday 18th August. More cows required.

Something for everyone from a Holstein Friesian, Ayrshire, Dairy Shorthorn to a Jersey x! A straight trade, with no real outstanding heifers to take the high spots. Best of the heifers from new vendor Phil Casson, Cote Farm Partnership, at 20days calved and yielding an impressive 36litres she was snapped up by Johnny Hoggarth, Slyne at £2080. Regulars Mark Atkinson and Stephen Lawson at £2020 and £2000 respectively, both heading home with Alex Walton to Wrea Green. Plenty of heifers in the £1800 bracket, others a shade less £1680-£1750. Cows in demand, John & Edward Fox with their 2<sup>nd</sup> calver realising the top spot of the day at £2180.

**Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander):** Best calves not quite as dear as previous weeks, but the trade for the younger calves was off the clock! Young Angus heifers £210-£240, with the strongest types £245-£260. Hereford heifers £250-£280, topping at £285 from John Livesey, Inskip. Native bulls topped at £315 from Phillip Wood with an Angus, others generally £260-£278, with some Jersery bred calves looking well sold £160-£180. Hereford bulls £240-£280 with a top of £300. Some nice continental calves forward, the best bulls to £450 for a smart Charolais from Robin Boothman, £430 from Ian Hodgson with a Blue Bull, £420 twice from Robin Boothman and Steve Wallbank with Limousins. Strongest continental heifers £320-£330, topping at £380 for a Limousin from NM Breaks. Younger Blue heifers great to sell, and often £230-£265. Black and white trade continues as seen over the last few weeks, weaned calves £190-£205, to a high of £255 from Roger Bainbridge. Strongest milk calves £85-£105 with the next bracket £55-£58, the plainer end upwards of £40, averaging £105.

Auctioneer's Report: (Greg MacDougall): As expected, a small show of ewes forward. A busy ringside of buyers including a few fresh faces resulted in a sharper trade than last week. Heavy ewes in particular good to sell and short of requirements with plenty of pens either side of £100. Suffolks to £128.50 from J & C Wright, Skipton with Texels to £126.50 from MJ & K Ayrton, Bambers Farm. Best ewes in general forward in small numbers and often £110-£120. Good selling lean types £70-£90. Mule ewes good to sell topping at £100 from GW Whitwell, Lanshaw. Heavy Mules £90-£96 with the next cut down middle £80s, plain £60+. Best Horned ewes £65-£75 with Swales from C Gibson & Son, Burneside Hall to £80. Mediums £40+ with plain £20-£30. Cast rams meeting a strong trade with MJ & K Ayrton topping the night's sale at £180 with Texel rams while others from R & SH Stainton sold to £165.



Auctioneer's Report: (Greg MacDougall): Lambs dearer than expected with an overall SQQ of 213ppk. More heavy lambs forward, light weights sharper on the week, contray to some earlier week auctions. Topping the sale per head was TD, ME & GE Todd, Sedbergh at £121.50. Top pence per kilo came from D & A Fenwick Ltd, Gainsborough who showed another nice run of well-fed lambs topping at 261.9ppk. Suffolks to a top of £105.50 from SG&LM Whalley, Chorley. Charollais to £105.50 & £108.50 again from D&A Fenwick. Lambs weighing 46-48kg generally £95-£100, with the heavier butchers types £101-£115. Handy weight smart lambs regularly 243-257ppk. Mules mostly over £2/kg, topping at 212ppk from R&SH Stainton, Howgill or £104.50 from P Williams, Melling.
