SPECIAL NOTE TO BUYERS:

Buyers who anticipate purchasing a large number of lambs are advised to approach the auctioneers prior to the start of the sale, who will then make every effort to assist in the after sale penning requirements.

The auctioneers are willing to assist buyers from away who may require help with arrangements for overnight accommodation, lairage and haulage.

LAIRAGE

Sheep can be lairaged overnight by arrangement within the Auction or Auction Fields. Please inform the office staff of likely collection time of your stock and give contact number of haulier being used. Arrangements for lairage should be made with either of the auctioneers Stephen Dennis, Greg MacDougall or Yard Foreman Tommy Abbott (Tel:- 07764346444)

<u>DIPPING:</u> All lambs must have been dipped or treated with scab approved product within 28 days of sale.

<u>EID TAGS</u>: All lambs must be double tagged, with one Electronic Tag (preferably top of near side ear) with matching ordinary tag. Vendors please note that auctioneers shall not be liable in any way for any deficiencies in either the vendor's tagging of his sheep nor the reading equipment being used in accordance with the EID regulations nor any reading or print out produced by said equipment as stated by the LAA.

COVID PROTOCOL TO BE FOLLOWED

****VENDORS****

Vendors will be allowed to attend the sale and represent their stock. However, this will be subject to **STRICT 2 metre social distancing** being adhered to which may be monitored by the local authority and in the event of non-compliance, the auction mart's licence to operate could be suspended.

The protocol listed below for vendors must be followed:

- a) Two vendors may attend per consignment i.e no extra family members or onlookers (only one vendor per consignment to represent stock in the sale ring)
- b) Prior to sale, vendors may stand by their pen(s) but must respect social distancing
- c) Vendors to follow their stock to the ring and represent their animals in the usual manner (only one vendor to access the sale ring)
- d) Following the sale of their stock, vendors to leave the sale ring (not to remain to watch other stock being sold or liaise with buyers i.e handing out luck)
- e) Luck money etc to be distributed by the auction staff. Please give instructions.
- f) Vendors at all times to maintain 2 metre social distancing

The above protocols are in place to ensure that we can maximise the number of buyers in the sale ring and it is in the interests of vendors that this happens.

Please pre-register with the auctioneers or the office (015242 61444) your intention to attend. You will also be required to register at the sale ring entrance prior to the sale. Pre-sale viewing of sheep will be allowed subject to social distancing being maintained. During the sale, please respect social distancing.
