Vendors please note that auctioneers shall not be liable in any way for any deficiencies in either the vendor's tagging of his sheep nor the reading equipment being used in accordance with the EID regulations nor any reading or print out produced by said equipment as stated by the LAA.

## ****VENDORS****

Vendors will be allowed to attend the sale and represent their stock. However, this will be subject to STRICT 2 metre social distancing being adhered to which may be monitored by the local authority and in the event of non-compliance, the auction mart's licence to operate could be suspended.
