Auctioneer's Report: (Greg MacDougall): The first special sale of store cattle had forward an entry just short of 900 head. A good turnout of both local and travelled buyers were in attendance all keen to purchase numbers. A good trade throughout with a complete clearance being achieved. Strong well fleshed and suckler bred cattle all good to sell with dairy bred sorts easier than a month ago especially those showing signs of the weather. Smart heifers selling at a premium and were in short supply often selling between £1050-£1200 topping at £1520 for a Limousin from J & JE Bradley, Penny Grange. Strongest cattle in general £1200-£1400 with J & A Lawson, High Threaber to £1500. Wintering sorts £900-£1000. Over 200 B + Ws forward, all a straight trade. Strong types £800-£1000 topping at £1020 from TD Inman, Milton Moor. Plainer end £600-£700 with a few younger types mid £500s. Next special sale Tuesday 6th October. 

Auctioneer's Report (Stephen Dennis): Another strong show of cast cows which again were well bid for. Heavier well fleshed B + W cows either side of 130p/kg. Messrs Polkinghorne of Butterfield Gap grossing £1028 (138p/kg) whilst an under age heifer from Tony Burrow, High Snab sold to £1106 (169p). Medium B + W's 100-120p/kg with plain sorts generally 60p-80p. Beef x cows again good to sell, the better end in the 140s-160s topping at 171p from for a BBx from Neil & Linda Allan.

Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): Another week in triple figures, with 121 forward. A mixed show, with more medium and small calves about. A run of the best from JM & AE Wallbank were in strong demand, his blue bulls £485 & £480, other strong blues £400-£430 with a few shapey smaller sorts £370-£390, the younger slightly plainer end £280-£320. Best of the Blue heifers to £410 again from Steve Wallbank, others generally £270-£305. Angus calves similar to previous weeks, £260-£290 with the stronger sorts £250-£270 with the best £430 & £435. A younger show of Angus heifers with the majority £150-£200 and the best well over at £310 from Brian Barnes. A sharper Black and White trade for the smaller sorts, whilst the stronger sorts sold to a similar trade on the week, to a top of £235, many others £120-£160, rearers £50-£80, averaging £92.

Auctioneer's Report: (Greg MacDougall): Very much a two tier trade with plenty of pens of lambs in the entry showing signs of the recent wet weather. Lambs which were coming off feed of all weight categories were in demand and selling at a premium. Heavy lambs in particular best to sell. Topping the night's sale was Beltex lambs from Susanna Dennis scaling 43kg realising £118 (274.4p). A great run of Charollais x lambs from B Poucher & Son, Horncastle sold to £116.50 to average £112.22. Local vendor Carol Parker also sold lambs to £116.50, all purchased by Andrew Atkinson Ltd. Smarter lambs in general 250p-270p with nicer commercial types 210p-220p. Lambs short of finish 200p-205p. Lambs 48kg-50kg in general £95-£105. Another large entry of Mules forward, trade 190p-200p with store types in the 170s. Heavy pens £90-£94 topping at £105. Horned lambs meeting the usual selective trade with best fleshy sorts around 180p.

Heavy types few and far between with trade for these either side of £100. Ewes topped at £130 for Texels from DR & JE Ellison. Best in general around £120. Good selling lean ewes £80-£90 with leaner or small sorts £60-£70. The heaviest of the Mule ewes £50-£60 with the stronger horned breeds £65-£75 topping at £75.50 for Lonks with Roughs to £68.50. Cast rams in strong demand with ME & CA Duerden, Killerwick topping the night's sale at £210 with two Continentals selling others to £205.
