PROTOCOL FOR VENDORS RE COVID 19

Vendors of Gimmer Lambs will be allowed to attend the sale and represent their stock. However, this will be subject to **STRICT 2 metre social distancing** being adhered to which may be monitored by the local authority and in the event of non-compliance, the auction mart's licence to operate could be suspended.

The protocol listed below for vendors must be followed:

- a) Two vendors may attend per consignment i.e no extra family members or onlookers (only one vendor per consignment to represent stock in the sale ring)
- b) Prior to sale, vendors may stand by their pen(s) but must respect social distancing
- c) Vendors to follow their stock to the ring and represent their animals in the usual manner (only one vendor to access the sale ring)
- d) Following the sale of their stock, vendors to leave the sale ring (not to remain to watch other stock being sold or liaise with buyers i.e handing out luck)
- e) Luck money etc to be distributed by the auction staff. Please give instructions.
- f) Vendors at all times to maintain 2 metre social distancing

The above protocols are in place to ensure that we can maximise the number of buyers in the sale ring and it is in the interests of vendors that this happens.

You will also be required to register at the sale ring entrance prior to the sale. Pre-sale viewing of lambs will be allowed subject to social distancing being maintained. During the sale, please respect social distancing.

Before loading please present Office Pass Out to Yard Staff prior to departure.
