Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): Another bumper entry of Store lambs with well over double on the year. Despite plenty of scare mongering in the press regarding Brexit Trade Deals, an enthusiastic ringside were once again out in force with trade similar on the fortnight. Topping the day's trading was Nigel Barker, Dalton Old Hall with Valais Black Nose realising £105. Beltex lambs from Tom Fishwick & K Calvert sold to £100. Best lambs in general £85-£98 with strong Texel and Suffolk x £80-£92. JC Wade showed a pen of 110 Texels from Overton Bush, Jedburgh to £85, medium terms lambs £75-£80 with grass lambs from May onwards £58-£65. Strongest of the Mule lambs £80-£83 with the next draw down £72-£79 with some small sorts around £60. A good show overall of Horned lambs with better pens £50-£60— topping at £62.50 for Swales from B Dickinson & Co, Brockstones with Kendal Roughs to £75 from W Beck & Son, Penrith. Small lambs £25/£45 depending on quality.

Robin Jennings was at the top of the heifers, with the best of his trio, a sweet heifer 13days calved and with a daily yield of 30litres selling to Bentham regular Alex Walton at £2320. Richard Robinson continues to provide the quality, his heifer realising £2220, whilst his second calved cow realised £2250. Best heifers over £2000, with a couple of others in the late teens. Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): All classes sold to another fast trade with more required to fulfil increasing buyer demand. The highlight of the evening's sale was the annual show with Procters Farm Ltd continuing their winning run. A fantastic pen of Beltex ewes took the Champion rosette and topped the night's sale at £185 being bought by Andrew Thompson. Procters showed further pens of Texels ewes to £174-£161. A & H Watson, Middleton Hall won both the Swaledale and Other Horned ewe section realising £77-£90.50. Away from the show, heavy ewes sold between £100-£125 with the best and pure ewes £130-£170. Good selling types £80-£95 with lean types £60-£80. Mule ewes now making £90+ for the heavier end with Wannops farms Ltd topping at £100. Next cut down £75-£85 with the lean types £60+. Best fleshy Swale ewes £60-£70 with a few exceptions and heavier horned breeds £70-£80. Medium sorts £50+ with plain types £30-£40. Best of the rams £110-£130 topping at £134.50 from JR Corless. Goats sold to £90 from F Brennand, Ellerbeck.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): The largest show for a week or two with just short of 4000 lambs forward. Despite more lambs on the market countrywide, trade remained firm for all classes. With just under 1500 hill breeds in, the overall average of the nights sale levelled at 213.4p (SQQ215p) Topping the nights sale at £133.50 was a pair of Beltex lambs scaling 50kg from Procters Farm Ltd, with Joe Bosworth, Rossendale topping per kilo at 306.8p. Best lambs in general selling between 250p-290p. A nice consignment of mainly Beltex x lambs from **Jackie and Brian Storey** topping at £114.50 to average £105, while Keven Marshalls load topped at £117.50. Commercial export lambs around 210p with a nicer lamb 225-235p. Heavy lambs in strong demand with 48kg+ £100-£110 with smarter pens £120-£130. Lambs 44kg-46kg selling around £94-£98. Lightweight lambs good to sell with seasonal rush now on. Smarter end 230-250p with xbred types 210-

220p. Horned lambs

200p+ for best meated types with the plainer lambs 170-190p. Heavier horned lambs selling in the £80's topping at £88.50 for Dalesbreds from JT&J Kelsall. Handyweight mules (38-42kg) 205-215p with heavier pens £94-£100.
