Ear Tags • Animals must be tagged before 9 months old (or 6 months if housed indoors) and, in any event, before they leave their birth holding. • An Electronic Slaughter Tag can be applied if an animal is intended for slaughter in the UK before 12 months of age.

All Tup Lambs are to be declared (preferably marked) and sold separately.

SHEEP MEDICINES:- Vendors must advise in writing if any of their animals are still within a withdrawal period for any medicines. Vendors are advised to Scab Dip or treat animals with a DEFRA approved product

Please have the full address (including postcode) & holding number for the destination of the sheep purchased when collecting your invoice and movement license.

Sheep Sale Tuesday 26th January

We strongly recommend all vendors to adopt the drop and go policy.

- Vendors should leave any instructions (luck money, reserves, lotting) in writing on the enclosed form at the unloading docks.

Should vendors insist on representing their stock, the following protocol applies and will be strictly adhered to:

- Once stock has been unloaded, vendors are to remain in their vehicles/outside of the auction buildings until their stock is due to be sold.
 - Vendors should make arrangements with the office staff or auctioneers to be called to the ring ready for their stock to be sold.
- Vendors should not congregate around the sale ring, doorways or around the auction pens.
- Once their stock has been sold, vendors should then leave the sale ring and auction mart buildings immediately.
- All protocol is subject to change as and when LAA guidance changes.

Please note this protocol is as per the LAA recommendations, whilst we appreciate this may be disappointing, it is for the safety of all customers and staff and to ensure the live auction system can continue to operate.

PURCHASERS

Buyers **MUST** register at the sale ring entrance prior to the sale. Pre-sale viewing of sheep will be allowed subject to social distancing being maintained. During the sale social distancing must be strictly adhered to.
