# Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> February FARMERS STIRKS 453 FORWARD

Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): No let up with the stirk trade this month, a big entry sold to full value from start to finish. Kicking the sale off were the younger end of the entry, these all selling to a very strong trade. Mark Ireland's 8 month Blue Heifers selling to £1050 and Blue bullocks at the same age at £1040. Yearling cattle ready for the grass regularly £750-£850, with the older stronger cattle equally as dear and often achieving £900-£1050. Topping the day's trade was Mason & Gardner, Chapel-le-Dale at £1220 with a tremendous Blue Bullock. Heifers suitable for breeding commanding a premium, the best of these peaking at £1200 from The Woodhouse Family of Crummack, with others all £1000+. Bulls well bid for, the Beresfords of High Gale back with another consignment topping at £1095, others nicely £880-£980. Dairy bullocks to £900 for Fleckviehs from Maurice Lawson, Norwegian Reds to £600 from EW & RM Towers. Black and whites as dear as they've been of late, the best to £990 from G&P Middleton, Garsdale, who sold others at £950. Next draw in the £800s, whilst 12-14m olds from PW & DW Roskell peaked at £780 & £760.

Auctioneer's Report (Stephen Dennis): In general, a better show of cows with rather more meat about. Holsteins averaged 120p/kg with better meated heavy cows 120-130p/kg. Top price for an underage milk heifer 172p/kg whilst Dean & Brennand grossed £1227 for an overage clean heifer weighing 735kg at 167p/kg. Fleckvieh x cows to £1050 or 150p/kg from Brian Barnes, Hawkin Hall whilst Simon Foster grossed £1200 for his 870kg Hereford cow at 838p/kg. More cows required. Grazing cows wanted.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): Another fantastic show of prime hoggs with a flying trade to match. Perhaps not the show of best bred hoggs on offer but a real show of well bred commercial and heavy weight types. All classes selling to full values with the 14 buyers present all keen to ensure numbers. A highlight of the sale was a wonderful consignment of 180 heavy hoggs from N Thorndyke topping at £160 to average £149.58. The night's sale was topped however at £166 for Texels from FA Nairey, Blackburn. Heavy hoggs in general £135-£155 depending on quality. Hoggs weighing 45-50kg often £125-£130. Best bred types 300p-340p topping at 343.9p from RF Morphet, Halton with GD & M Howsam close behind at 341.5p. Commercial types 270p-290p. Handy weight Mules 270p-280p topping at 282.9p from L Broster, Huddersfield. Heavies £120+ topping at £127.50 from Messrs Sayer, Hackthorpe. Best fleshy Swales 260-270p with JT & J Kelsall topping per head at £124.50. SBF to £128.50 from AA & HM Capstick or 290.8p from G & E Robinson, Clitheroe. Lightweights of all breeds in strong demand with the best to 314.5p from NL & CJ Brown, Claughton Hall. Continentals in general 280-300p.

#### **COVID-19 UPDATE**

### The following protocol is now in place:

- Drop & Go Policy to be reinstated for all vendors (*Relevant paperwork* (*licenses, passports, entry forms etc.*) to be handed to auction representative at the unloading docks together with any instructions RE lotting, reserve prices and luck money).
- Sale Day payments will not be possible but cheques and BACS statements will be posted out as normal on Fridays.
- Buyers MUST sign in on arrival outside the sale ring.
- Attendance at markets must be restricted to those conducting business and only 1 buyer per business is permitted to enter the site
- Face coverings must be worn by everyone attending the site, at all times (this includes market staff) exemptions are permitted for anyone with a medical condition that allows a face covering not to be worn.
- Strict Social Distancing to be maintained (minimum of 2 metres). The wearing of face coverings is NOT a substitute for the need to maintain Social Distancing at all times.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): With the cast sheep numbers now showing signs of drying up, all classes were once again in strong demand with trade £10-£20 sharper on the week. More required to fulfil orders for a very competitive ringside of buyers. Best bred and pure ewes met with fierce competition with Texels topping the night's sale at £181.50 from Mosside Farm with RF Towers close behind at £180. Trade in general £150-£180. Heavy ewes £110-£140 with good selling lean types around £100. Strongest pens of Mule ewes £100+ with a few pens sneaking past £110 to top at £117.50. Medium sorts £90-£97 with the leaner end £70+. The strongest SBF and Swale ewes £70-£90 with SBF to £94.50 from G & R Dawson, Crayke with Swales to £92.50 from Barrie Thomas. Medium types £60+ with the plainer end £40-£50. Strongest of the rams to £143.50 from R Polkinghorne with the best in general £120-£140. Lean types £100-£110. Hill rams few in number and selling to £104.50. Overall average £91.85.
