Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): A straight show of calves, with something for everyone. Not the biggest audience of buyers, but all classes meeting firm demand. A run of quality from Gordon Lewis kicked off the sale, his first Blue Bull topping the day at £485, with another two at £470. Other blue bulls regularly in the late £300's whilst the younger sorts either side of £300. Other continental bulls a bit younger, the best of the Lims to £295 from J & N Ashton. Angus bulls to £400 from W&S Airey, West Hall and J Lawson & Son, Bentham, others in the mid £300's, with the younger sorts £270-£290. Blue Heifers £300-£360, topping at £370 from A & MA Wright, Stauvins. A strong show of Angus heifers all bar one £235+, topping at £265. A major shortage of Black and White bulls with only 9 forward, Dave Martin's best to £185, the Wrights again up at the top with their best at £170, a few younger sorts looking well sold £50-£80, more dairy bulls needed of all ages to meet buyer demand!

Auctioneer's Report (Stephen Dennis): The largest entry of sheep & lambs forward this season, A good audience of buyers including Scottish representation. First into the ring, yours truly, with a pair of Texel x ewes suckling twin Beltex x lambs selling to George Bell for the day's top price of £282 followed closely by Frankland Farms with similar outfits at £280. Broken mouthed outfits from Michael Dugdale at £265. Overall, the better CTL x outfits £240-£260 with the general run £200-£235. Singles £150-£170 topped by Robert Johnson of Harrogate at £175. Mule ewes with twins also dearer on the week with the better couples either side of £200 and lesser sheep £160-£180. Another good entry expected next week with plenty of choice on offer.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): A much larger entry of cast sheep. Some good consignments from Lincoln and East Yorkshire as well as first time vendors from Northern Ireland. Heavy ewes just a shade easier with lightweight and hill types every bit as dear with some looking particularly well sold. P & I Tulpin, Skegness taking advantage of the strong competition was rewarded with the night's top price selling Texels to £178 with this consignment averaging £134.29. JR Simpson of Fadmoor also enjoyed a brisk trade selling Texels to £173.50 and Suffolks to £170. Cast rams peaked at £168 from G Taggert, Antrim. Best bred types in general £140-£170 with heavy ewes £120-£150. Good selling sorts £100-£120. The heaviest of the Mule ewes £100+ topping at £117.50 from GF & CH Johnson, York with the next draw down in the £90s, Lean sorts £75+. Best horned ewes once again selling well into the £80s with SBF topping the section at £90. medium types £70+ with leaner sorts £40-£50. Heavier rams £130-£160. Plainer hill rams £70-£90 with Cheviots topping the section at £100 from Bowhill Farming Ltd, Selkirk. A large entry of goats forward sold to £126 from G Taggert with local vendors B & F Staveley to £109.50.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): For anyone sat at home watching the livestream, it would be clear to see the large number of Swaledale and other hillbred hoggs in the total entry. Heavy weight and well finished export sorts few and far between and certainly selling to a premium. A very respectable overall average of 278.1p SQQ 278.8p was definitely a pleasing result. It may be of interest that hoggs are up some 106.4p on the year bearing in mind that the job went into disarray at the beginning of the Coronavirus a year ago. Topping the night's sale again this week were Beltex from J Bosworth realising £175 or 380.4p. Wannops Farms Ltd close behind at £172.50, late in the night, JR Metcalfe sold a nice run of CTLs topping at 360.5p. Best types in general 330p-360p with commercial sorts 290p-310p. Best heavy hoggs short of requirements after selling between £155-£170. Handy weight Mules 272p-283p with RI & AML Sidebottom topping at £134 or 285.1p. K & GJ Huck topping with Swales at £120.50 with R & P Parkinson at 278.2p. Trade in general for meat 260p-270p with grassy types 250p. Messrs Coates once again showed a marvellous run of Dalesbreds to £132 with handy types to 294.2p. Lightweights 260p+ with store types 230p-250p. CTLs to 324.3p from J & M Whitfield. Best 280p-300p with others 250p-280p.

Auctioneer's Report (Stephen Dennis): For the 24th March, an entry of 98 spring lambs was more than could have been expected. However the entry proved to be well short of requirements as a full ringside of buyers all sought to fulfil orders. The Pre-Sale Show was expertly judged by Andrew Atkinson who awarded the Champion prize to the Jenkinson Family from Stalmine with Freddie Jenkinson selling the 41kg Beltex/Texel lamb to the judge for £222 (541ppkg). Freddie also took 2nd place with a 40kg lamb ___ making £184 to the same

buyer. Charollais x lambs took 3rd, 4th and 5th place in the CTL class shown by Messrs Ingram, Logie Durno, The Marwood Family of Whenby and Robert Towers, Ingleton. A pure bred Suffolk lamb from GI Richmond, Goosnargh took 1st Prize in the native class realising £158 again to the judge. Other notable native bred lambs included a pen of 4 Hampshires weighing 41kg from Gary Atkinson selling for £160/head. Export weight lambs in short supply and generally 350p-450p/kg. Plenty of weight with the Charollais lambs weighing up to 67kg from pedigree tup breeders Messrs Ingram making the 315 mile journey from Aberdeenshire selling their heavy weights from £174-£185. Lambs required weekly, please keep in touch with the Auctioneers to inform them of likely numbers forward.
