Others generally £1750-£1800, with the next draw £1600-£1700. A couple of Jersey x Holstein Heifers from the Lawrence Family look nicely sold at £1520 & £1450. George and David Whitwell presented a pair of super second calved cows, the first realising £2100 to Tom & Jonathon Pollock, with the second close behind at £2000. A run of Dairy Shorthorn Bulling Heifers from Jane & Simon Foster, Gargrave peaked at £900 twice, averaging £872.

Auctioneer's Report (Will Alexander): Dairy bulls up another gear, a super run of eight 9-10week bulls from John & Nicola Young all sold over £210, topping at £270, to average £230, younger sorts all in the mid £100s, with even the small light calves £80-£110, a trio of Norwegian Reds from Alec Lambert £142-£158, with SPA Rushton topping both this section at £190 and the Fleckviehs at £290. Best calves continue to sell well in excess of £400, the best bulls from John Sandwith, Leeds peaking at £500, with his Lim Heifer close behind at £490. Doug Wallbank showing the best Blues, topping at £435, with others to £430 from Dave Martin, Kendal and Andrew Booth, Austwick. Second rate continental calves in the mid £300s with the smaller plainer types a little harder to place. Best Angus to £455 & £450 from J Lawson & Son, none of the middle rate sorts but the smalls looking well sold either side of £220. Blue heifers to £345 from J & N Young, Jenkin Cragg, Angus' to £290 from Jim Gorst, Mealbank.

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): Another large entry of cast sheep with plenty of farmer customers beginning to clear out lambing shed as well as a few fed ewes. Heavy ewes not the same fiery trade as last week and back to prices seen two weeks ago, if not a little more. Horned ewes and lighter sorts meeting with similar rates and look particularly well sold. Topping the night's sale at £190 were Texels from James Sanderson, Halton. Best and pure ewes in general £150-£190 with heavy sorts £130-£160. Good selling lean ewes £100+ with plain types £80+. Mule

ewes to £140 from GA & A Atkinson with heavy pens in general £120-£135. Small meaty types £105-£115 with plain around £90. Strongest Horned ewes well over £100+ with Roughs to £126.50, a pen of Swales to £112.50, Dales to £109.50, a pen of SBF to £100. Medium sorts £80-£90 with lean types £60+. Over 80 cast rams in the entry saw heavy sorts £160-£180 topping at £182 from Mission Springs. Next draw down £130-£150 with best hill rams around £100 with Herdwicks topping at £110.50 from B Dickinson, Brockstones.

Auctioneer's Report (Stephen Dennis): Not quite the extreme rates of last week's sale but trade ahead of expectations averaging overall 295p/kg for another huge show of 4363 hogs on a week where most centres seemed short of numbers. Tim Mason of Malton again stole the show with another fine run of quality hogs topping the sale at £204.50 averaging over £185 for his entire consignment. Heavy hogs were otherwise generally £150-£160 still 280p-300p/kg. Export weight hogs good to sell, generally 295p-315p/kg as were the handy weights (36-38kg) which looked very well sold between 300p-320p/kg. Best quality hogs either side of 350p/kg. An abundance of hillbred lambs throughout the sale but well bid for and generally 280p-300p/kg.
