

Vendors of heavy hoggs would be bitterly disappointed with their returns with trade very limited and wholesalers reporting the worst. Topping the sale with another nice run of Beltex hoggs was JM Andrews, Boscar Flats realising £175.50 with others to £174 and £170 x 2. Best per kilo came from M Salisbury & Son, Hayfield at 387.5p with JR Metcalfe of Thirsk selling his best pen to £170 or 386.4p. RJ Capstick, Yew Tree Farm showed another nice run to top at £159 with Will Oldfield, Gisburn selling his best pen to £154. A nice run of smart hoggs from Ben Haigh making the trip from Hexham topped at £164. First time vendors SP Woolhouse & Sons Ltd, Doncaster presented a great run of fed hoggs which were very well received by the buyers, they topped at £164.50 with others to £163, £162, £160 and averaging £143.24. Commercial hoggs 45-48kg often £114-£118 with 50kg sheep either side of £120. Heavy weights £125-£135 with the best £140-£160. Handy weight commercials 270p-280p with plain types and Mules 250-260p. Considering some trades in the week, a respectable average of 252.5p SQQ 258.9p was achieved. The advice is most definitely don't get hoggs too big.
