Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): The phenomenal cast sheep trade continues with some of the best prices ever seen being achieved. Another decent entry forward with buyers all keen to ensure large numbers with Ramadan set to begin on Saturday. Topping the night’s sale at $£ 300$ was a Texel ewe from long time supporter of the auction P \& JM Wilson \& Son, Eccles Farm. Countless pens of heavy and best bred ewes selling over $£ 200$ with several between $£ 230-£ 240$. Heaviest of the cross bred ewes $£ 190-£ 200$ with plenty of lean good selling types $£ 130-£ 150$. Smaller ewes and lean types $£ 100+$. Mule ewes to a top of £166.50 from High Harbour Farm with plenty of other pens $£ 135-£ 145$. Leaner sorts $£ 110-$ $£ 120$. A strong trade for all classes of horned ewes. The plainer pens often between $£ 50-$ $£ 60$ with small meaty types $£ 80-£ 90$. Plenty of strong ewes $£ 100$ with some getting into the $£ 120$ s with Dalesbreds from Messrs Coates, Rainscar topping at $£ 127.50$. A similar number of cast rams averaging $£ 182.94$ all in with Messrs Deakin, Sutton in Ashfield topping at $£ 242$. The heaviest $£ 200+$ with leaner types $£ 150-£ 180$. ## PRIME HOGGS 6710 Forward <br> Overall Av 268.4p SQQ 277.1p

Auctioneer's Report (Greg MacDougall): One of the biggest shows for some time with 6710 prime hoggs forward. Some quality runs of well fed sheep in the entry coming from the Scottish Borders to Shropshire as well as East Yorkshire and Norfolk with the every growing customer base from Lincolnshire seemingly increasing on a weekly basis. With extra customers in attendance, best bred handy weights sold at extreme rates. DN \& D Capstick topped the sale this week at $£ 207$ with a single Beltex hogg with the same home also topping per kilo at 478.1p with a pen of six. Messrs Sayer , Penrith also broke the $£ 200$ barrier with the best from the consignment to $£ 205$ or 465.9 p. A great run of quality hoggs from $P$ \& I Tuplin, Skegness sold to $£ 198.50$ with locals Wannops Farm Ltd to $£ 197.50$. T Hill \& R Wright enjoyed another flying trade with this consignment of 150 topping at $£ 196$ to average $£ 160$. Other notable prices per kilo: JM Hall, Skipton 453.6p, DN \& D Capstick 450p, P \& I Tuplin 441.1p, AT Burrow \& Son 437.8p. A little cut down from the real machines 350-380p with the best commercial hoggs around 300 p. Handy weight first cross hoggs $270-290$ p. A hogg weighing $45-48 \mathrm{~kg}$ more likely to make $£ 122-£ 125$ this week with the 50 kg hoggs getting into the $£ 130$ s more often than not with smarter pens $£ 150+$. A great run in this weight category from GA Stephens, Melton Mowbray topping at $£ 163.50$. Heavier Mule hoggs $£ 120-£ 125$ with the handier weights $260-270$ p topping at 282.1p. Stronger Swale and SBF hoggs $£ 110-£ 117$ with a pen of 46 kg from M \& YS Barker to $£ 119.50$. Handy weights either side of 260p. Nearly 700 Cheviots averaged 270 p with most pens $£ 122-£ 127$. Heavier sorts $£ 130+$. Lighter weights as long as they were well fleshed good to sell. Continentals 270-300p with some nicer pens 300p+. A run of 400 Herdwicks from first time vendor E \& SM Taylforth, Great Langdale topped at $£ 108$ to average $£ 92.58$. Once again, bearing in mind the large numbers of hill bred and over weight hoggs in Bentham a very pleasing average of 268.4 p (SQQ 277.1 p) was achieved (up 10.5 p or 14.3 p on the week).
