All Tup Lambs are to be declared, preferably marked and sold separately.

SHEEP MEDICINES:- Vendors must advise in writing if any of their animals are still within a withdrawal period for any medicines. Vendors are advised to Scab Dip or treat animals with a DEFRA approved product

Purchasers, please have the full address (including postcode) & holding number for the destination of the sheep purchased when collecting your invoice and movement license.
