NOTES

- This document meets the reporting rules in the Sheep and Goats (Records, Identification and Movement) (England) Order 2009, as amended, and Article 4 of EC Regulation 1/2005 on welfare of animals during transport and related operations requiring transporters to carry an Animal Transport Certificate, recording the origin /ownership of the animals, places of departure / destination and information allowing journey times to be assessed.
- Complete all fields, to comply with para. 1 above.
- The CPHs of the premises from which the animals are departing, and to which they are travelling must be recorded.
- Addresses must likewise accurately reflect where the animals are moving from and to.
- This is a single movement reporting document. Each stage of a multiple move must be completed on a separate document.
- If section 1 is not completed by the departure keeper, it must not be completed by the destination keeper (LIS will contact them for that information)

 Vet Attestation Number (section 1) - enter this 20 digit number (provided to you by your vet after an animal health visit) see example below. Without it meat and products from the animals might not be eligible for export.
